# **ECONOMIC IMPACT CALCULATOR**



## What is the 2022 PA Aviation Economic Impact Study (PA EIS)?

- The PA EIS estimates the economic impact of 122 public-use airports\* across the state. Sources of impact include airport administration, tenant activity, capital expenditures, and visitor spending.
- The study is updated regularly by the PennDOT Bureau of Aviation to reflect changes in airport activity and the economy.

Results are presented by category at the direct, multiplier and total levels:



Total number of jobs



Total compensation of those jobs



Expenditures, sales, revenues

### What is the Economic Impact Calculator?

Allows users to estimate changes to an airport's economic impact based on real or hypothetical scenarios



Helps airport sponsors and other stakeholders better understand and communicate an airport's economic contribution to the economy.

#### Example Scenarios

- Increase/decrease in airport or tenant employment
- Gain/loss of an airport business tenant
- Increase/decrease in airport or tenant capital expenditures
- Gain/loss of out-of-state visitors arriving by air
