

BARGAIN ROAD BRIDGE PRESERVATION PROJECT, ERIE COUNTY

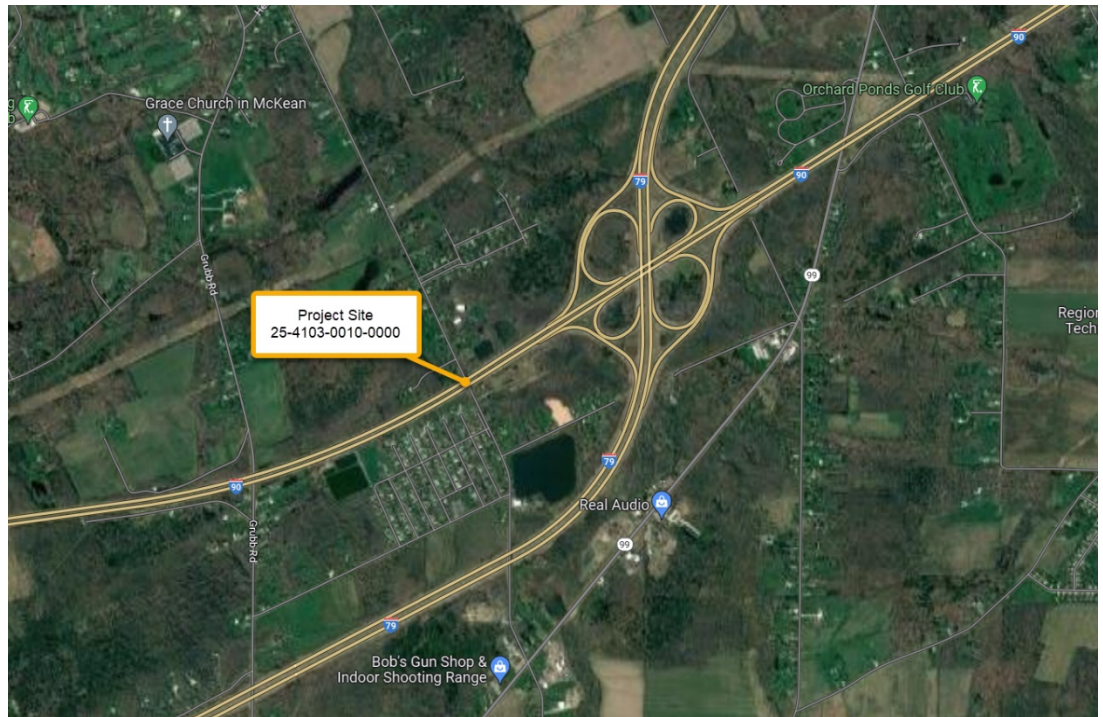
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proposed scope of work includes the rehabilitation of the structure carries Bargain Road (Route 4103) over Interstate 90 in McKean Township, Erie County.

The existing concrete box beam bridge was built in 1959. Approximately 750 vehicles a day use the bridge, on average.

PROJECT AREA

The bridge is located on Bargain Road (Route 4103), approximately 1/2 mile west from the intersection of Interstate 79.



PROPOSED PLAN

Work will involve milling of existing asphalt, deck repairs, minor barrier modifications for approach bridge connections, pier joint encasement and waterproof membrane and asphalt overlay applied to the deck. The roadway approach pavement will be milled. Asphalt to be overlaid along placement of road shoulder backup material. There will be no major change in roadway grade.

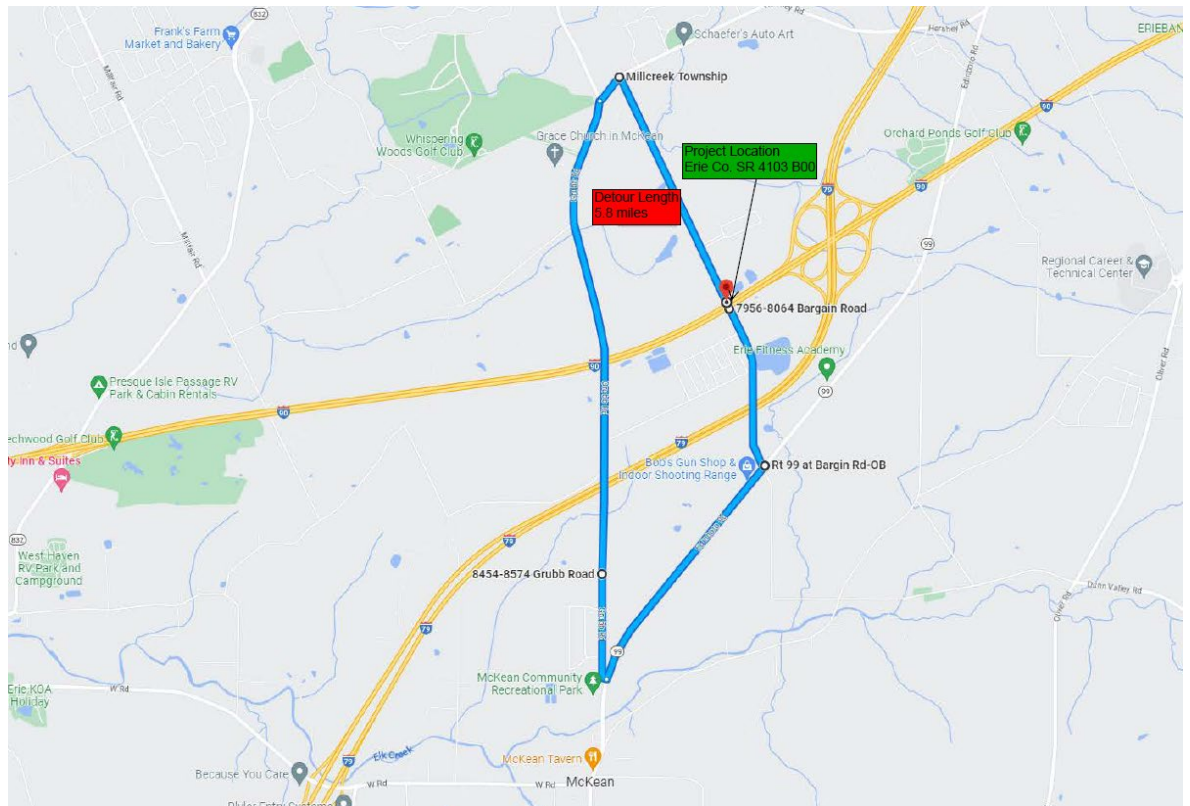
ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Work is expected to occur during the 2024 construction season and will last approximately two months.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

A detour will be required for construction and is expected to be in place for approximately two months. The proposed 5.8-mile detour route will be posted using Route 99 (Edinboro Road) and Grubb Road (Route 4011).



CONSTRUCTION FUNDING

The estimated construction cost is \$400,000.

CURRENT PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The purpose of the virtual public online plans display is to introduce the project and receive public input regarding any questions or concerns with the project. It is also an opportunity for the public to review and comment on the project's potential effect upon Cultural Resources pursuant to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's 36 CFR Part 800 regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
