

PUBLIC INVOVLEMENT HANDOUT

ROUTE 58 BRIDGE PROJECT, GROVE CITY, MERCER COUNTY

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The purpose of the project is to replace a portion of the bridge that carries Route 58 over Wolf Creek in Grove City Borough, Mercer County.


The existing prestressed spread concrete beams, deck, sidewalks, and barrier will be replaced with new prestressed concrete beams, reinforced concrete deck, sidewalks and barriers. Work will also include waterproof membrane, bituminous overlay, and updated guiderail and pavement markings. The proposed curb to curb width is 33 feet. The structure will remain on the same existing alignment.

Permanent and temporary Right-Of-Way takes will be required on both sides of the structure for construction. Cunningham Mill Park is located in the southwest portion of the project area and will have temporary impacts during construction.

The existing structure was built in 1967 and the superstructure, which is the upper portion of the bridge, is in poor condition. Approximately 9,800 vehicles a day use the bridge.

PROJECT AREA

The bridge is located on Route 58 (East Main Street) at the intersection with Route 173 and near the entrance to Grove City College.





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ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION


Work is expected to occur during the 2025 construction season and will take approximately seven months.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Car and pedestrian traffic will be maintained with halfwidth construction at the bridge.

A detour will be posted for truck traffic and is expected to be in place for approximately seven months. The proposed 14-mile detour route will be posted using Route 58, Route 8, and Route 208.

The truck detour will be in place for approximately seven months during the 2025 construction season.



CONSTRUCTION FUNDING

The project construction funds are 100% state funded with an estimated total of \$2,000,000.

CURRENT PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The purpose of the public comment period is to introduce the project and receive input regarding any questions or concerns with the project. It is also an opportunity for the public to review and comment on the project's potential effect upon Cultural Resources pursuant to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's 36 CFR Part 800 regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. The project documents can be made available in alternative languages or formats if requested.
