

Highway Resurfacing and Bridge Preservation

- SR 6-179 HIGHWAY RESURFACING
- SR 2005-026 HIGHWAY RESURFACING
- SR 6-135/202 BRIDGE PRESERVATION OVER TIOGA RIVER
- Construction Cost \$7.3 Million


Proposed Improvements

- √ Resurface Roadways with Base / Joint Repairs
- ✓ Replace Drainage at Select Locations
- ✓ Utility Work (Water, Sewer, Gas)
- ✓ ADA Curb Ramps
- ✓ Guide Rail Replacement
- ✓ Update Signing and Pavement Markings
- ✓ Bridge Preservation over Tioga River

TRAFFIC CONTROL

Utilize Short-term Flagging Operations


- Pennsylvania Standard Applications (PATAs)
- Maintain 1 travel lane
- Working hours Set up and tear down the shortterm construction work zones each shift
- Non-working hours Reopen all lanes of traffic and the adjacent shoulders and/or parking lanes to traffic
- Night Work in Central Business District
- Closure Lengths and Durations
 - Access to businesses Maintained at all times
 - Striving to minimize disruptions to parking and street access



TRAFFIC CONTROL

Night Work

- Coordinated with Mansfield Borough during design phase
- Central Business District (CBD) No lane restrictions from 6:00 AM - 8:00 PM.
- SR 6 between SR 1001 (Lambs Creek Road) and North Academy Street.
- SR 2005 between East Main Street and SR 1002 (E. Elmira Street)
- Illumination in the work zone
- Work Shifts Sunday Night through Friday Morning



TRAFFIC CONTROL

Directional Detour / Bridge Work


- Eastbound travel lane open on SR 6
- Temporary traffic signal timing adjustments and phase changes along detour.

Temporary Parking Impacts

- Night-time ONLY
- Active Work Zone areas per Contractor
- Police enforcement for parked vehicles


Special Events


 No traffic disruptions during known events (4th of July Parade, Mountie Days, Homecoming, Trunk or Treat, 5k races, etc.)



TRAFFIC CONTROL – BRIDGE WORK

STAGED CONSTRUCTION WITH DIRECTIONAL DETOUR
June 10, 2024 thru August 13, 2024





DRAINAGE OVERVIEW

- ✓ Facilitates resurfacing between curb lines.
- ✓ Addresses deteriorated pipes and problematic areas
- √ Improves highway drainage
 - ✓ Meet PennDOT design standards, where feasible.
 - ✓ Add more inlets and larger pipes, where feasible.
- ✓ Maintains discharge points and Borough's MS4 network
- ✓ Cost Sharing and Establishes Maintenance Responsibilities with Mansfield Borough

What will the Drainage Revisions Not Do?

- Improve drainage in other parts of the Borough
- ❖ Alter the Arch Pipe Conduit
- ❖ Alter the Corey Creek Culvert or River Levee System
- Alter amount of stormwater runoff
- * Resolve problems beyond the limits of work

UTILITIES

What to expect:

- Water, Gas, Sanitary and Aerial Utilities will require adjustments.
- Aerial Relocations Prior (Complete)
- Water/Sewer Incorporated Work
- Gas Coordinated Work



ANTICIPATED SCHEDULE

- Contractor Start Work Mid May 2024
- 2024 Planned Work (Subject to Change**)
 - Bridge Preservation Over Tioga River
 - ADA Ramps
 - Tree Trimming
 - Waterline Relocations
 - Drainage Improvments
- No physical work Nov 4, 2024 to Apr 20, 2025

- 2025 Planned Work (Subject to Change**)
 - Remaining Drainage
 - Base Repairs
 - Milling and Resurfacing
 - Guide Rail / Signing / Pavement Markings
 - Complete work Mid October, 2025
